Thank you for considering Oroiquis/Heron Court Permanent Supportive Housing Apartments as your new home! We are providing a one-page description of each site. <u>If you want to be placed on our waiting list for Oroiquis Apartments or Heron Court Apartments, you MUST apply online at grhousing.org or complete the attached GRHC paper application.</u>

Oroiquis and Heron Court Apartments offer permanent supportive housing to all individuals that qualify. In order to have your application considered, <u>all</u> of the following qualifications must be met:

- Applicant must have a verifiable disability,
- Applicant's income must be less than HUD's 2010 established income guidelines for several different levels of income. The following is an example of Area Median Income (AMI) for a one person family size for four levels:

30% AMI (\$13,890) 50% AMI (\$23,150) 40% AMI (\$18,520) 60% AMI (\$27,780)

Preferences are given to applicants who have been or are homeless, or at risk of homelessness.

IN ORDER FOR US TO PROCESS YOUR APPLICATION, PLEASE FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS BELOW:

- 1. Please fill out the front and back of all enclosed forms:
 - a. Application for Genesis housing
 - b. The questionnaire regarding Request for Reasonable Accommodations
 - c. The Grand Rapids Housing Commission Housing Application
 - d. Be sure to sign and return via mail or delivery to 528 Bridge St. NW, Suite 6, Grand Rapids, MI 49504
- 2. You will need to have the following information available when we call to process your application:
 - a. A photocopy or valid picture identification and Social Security card
 - b. Recent proof of all income you receive (Social Security or SSI letters, last four paycheck stubs, DHS, etc.)
 - c. Proof of any assets (bank statements, property, stocks, etc.)
- 3. Genesis will obtain the following at the time your application is processed:
 - a. A credit report
 - b. Previous landlord references
 - c. A Grand Rapids and Michigan State criminal record check
 - d. Verification of income and assets
 - e. Verification of Disability
